THE FLAG, IN BLACK AND WHITE, STARK AND PRECISE COLORS, THAT SHOW THE TRUE AND UNDENIABLE FACT THAT AMERICAN MEN ARE STILL MISSING. THE PROFILE OF THE PRISONER SHOWS HE IS BENT IN SORROW, NOT IN DEFEAT!

HE FACES TO HIS RIGHT, TOWARDS HIS HOMELAND, AMERICA, IN THE CONTINUING BELIEF THAT HE HAS NOT BEEN FORGOTTEN. HE WAITS, ENDURING THE INDIGNITY OF CAPTIVITY, FOR THE DAY, WHEN THE FREEDOM THAT HE FOUGHT FOR, WILL BE RETURNED TO HIM.

IN THE BACKGROUND, A GUARD WATCHES THE PRISONER, DISTANT AND APART FROM THE POW – BOTH IN BODY, AND SPIRIT, BECAUSE <u>THE GUARD</u> <u>DOES NOT CARE.</u> BARBED WIRE SEPARATES THEM, JUST AS THE LOVE OF FREEDOM, SEPARATES <u>US</u> FROM THOSE, WHO WOULD <u>TAKE AWAY</u> FREEDOM.




THE DANDELION
